

Tech Supply Rack Installation

Do-it-Your-Self Instructions



Parts Included

- Back door rack (68160039)
- Back door rack hanger (68160119)
- Graphics package for rack (Optional)
 - Grinding wheels/wire brushes (43030048)
 - Drill bits/drill bit sets (43030049)
 - Punches & Chisels (43030050)
 - Shop supplies/Rotary disks (43030051)
 - Safety equipment (43030047)
- Graphics package for rear door (Optional)
 - Left graphic (43030044)
 - Right graphic (43030045)
 - Bottom graphic (43030046)

Tools

- Cordless drill
- Phillips adaptor
- Tape measure

- Utility/razor knife
- Spray adhesive (3M)
- A cleaner: window cleaner (409/Amonia base)

- Masking tape

Note: * These steps refer to the installation of the graphics only. Graphics are an optional package and are not included with the purchase of a back door rack/Tech center.

Step 1: Remove all the lace in the rear door using a utility/razor knife. (Fig. 1)

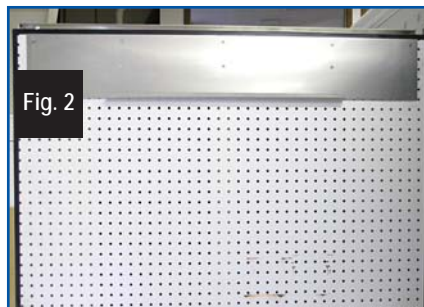

Step 2: You will be mounting hardware and graphics to the surface of the peg board. The surface must be clean and free of debris or loose material. Wipe down the rear door with cleaner and a rag removing all debris or surface marks. Also, make sure ALL exposed screw heads are recessed.

Step 3: Mount the back door rack hanger. (Fig. 2)



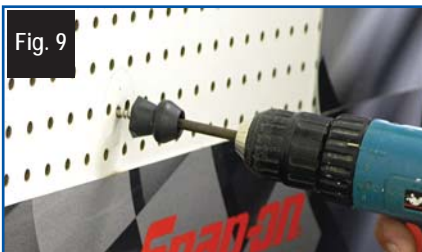

***Step 4:** Mount the header graphic as follows: To avoid over spray on other surfaces, mask off the area around the back door rack hanger with masking tape and/or disposable paper. (DO NOT USE NEWSPAPER) Take the header graphic ('Tech Supply Center') and turning it over (facedown) thoroughly apply adhesive on the backside of the graphic. (Fig. 3) Allow adhesive to become tacky to the touch. Before you mount the header graphic apply adhesive on the top of the rear door rack hanger surface. Cover the whole width and approximately as high as the graphic. (Fig. 4) Wait until the glue is tacky.

***Step 7:** Make the header graphic application as follows: Center the graphic on the door and along the top. Press firmly so both glued surfaces make good contact and bond evenly. (Fig. 5)

***Step 8:** Trim off any excess graphic on each side using utility/razor knife and straight edge. Always keep utility/razor knife blade away from your hands & body! Keep decal tight and use a sharp blade.

***Step 9:** When mounting side graphics first line up pattern before gluing anything. (Fig. 6) Establish position of graphic using masking tape to mark inside vertical edge. To avoid overspray on the peg board mask off the area with masking tape and disposable paper. (DO NOT USE NEWSPAPER) Cover the rear of the side graphic and the mounting area of the peg board with adhesive and allow time for both of the surfaces to become tacky. Make application of both right and left vertical graphics so both glued surfaces make good contact and bond evenly.

***Step 10:** Apply adhesive to the rear of the bottom graphic and the peg board surface like you did with the header graphic. Make application of the bottom graphic so both surfaces make good contact and bond evenly.

Step 11: Hook rack on lip of door hanger. (Fig. 7)

Step 12: Locate back door rubber receiver (located towards bottom of rack) push tight to the door and trace out. (Fig. 8) Remove back door rack, with rack down; remove rubber receiver and screw to door where traced out. (Fig. 9)

Step 13: Repeat step 11 and connect back door holder in place.

Step 14: On top of rack thread black knobs into place to securely fasten back door rack.
